Peaceful protests against then President Ali Abdullah Saleh in 2011 escalated into a full-scale civil war in 2015



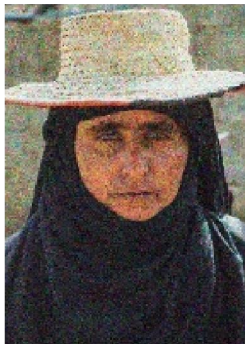
In a country of approximately 27 million people, 19 million Yemenis are in need of humanitarian assistance



10.3 million Yemenis are in acute need of help



7.3 million Yemenis are affected by famine



3 million Yemenis have been internally displaced



Nearly 14,000 Yemeni civilians have died since 2015



Only about half of all Yemeni hospitals are operating and these are running out of money and supplies



Since March 2015, the UK has sold an estimated £3.3 billion worth of bombs and fighter jets to Saudi Arabia
