Dr Hackman is a case active forensic anthropologist who is a certified Level 1 forensic anthropologist accredited by examination by the Royal Anthropological Institute of Great Britain and Ireland (RAI) and she is a registered expert practitioner in forensic anthropology on the forensic expert database of the National Crime Agency. Her expertise has been utilised in investigations including human trafficking, murder, paedophilic incidents, terrorist incidents and child abuse as well as missing persons investigations and she has given evidence in court throughout the UK.
